Dear Fulton County Community:

Governor Wolf has announced that all school districts will close for two weeks, effective Monday, March 16th, in a response to growing concerns statewide about the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). Tentative plans are for classes to resume on Monday, March 30th.

- This closure includes all practices, games, extra-curricular activities, field trips, and any other school-related event effective tomorrow, Saturday, March 14th.
- All off-campus educational programs associated with the districts are also canceled during this time period.
- Faculty, staff, coaches, students, and community members will not be permitted on any school campus without prior approval from the superintendent.
- Necessary communications with school employees should be, when possible, made by email. Staff will be checking email at least daily. You may also leave a voice mail at school offices, but no one will be immediately available to answer phone calls.
- Please monitor district websites regularly as schools will post updates on operations when they become available.

The state has decided to take these steps working in cooperation with local, state, and federal authorities who are working to minimize the impact of the Coronavirus on the health of our community.
